- Care for people;
- Care for the earth; and
- Redistributing everything surplus to one's needs.

This completely revised and updated edition of Rosemary Morrow's highly successful **Earth User's Guide to Permaculture** is a straight-forward manual of practical permaculture. Fundamentally, permaculture is design science and in this new edition design is emphasised. This book will be most beneficial if you apply it to the space where you live and work.
